



## ***Clinical Chemistry and Laboratory Medicine – 2007 subscription offer for clinical chemistry societies***

### **1. Individual subscription for members of IFCC societies: "print & online"**

Individual society members may subscribe on their own to **CCLM** "print & online" on an individual, non-mandatory basis at the substantially reduced rate of **€ 130.00 /\$ 176.00** (postage and handling included) per year.

### **2. Individual subscription for members of IFCC societies: "online-only"**

IFCC Society members may subscribe on their own to **CCLM** "online-only" on an individual, non-mandatory basis.

- Online-only subscription exclusively for members of societies affiliated with IFCC:  
**E 50.00/ \$68.00**

### **3. Society Block subscription, "print & online" on a voluntary basis**

IFCC societies currently have the option of purchasing block subscriptions for their members on an annual, non-mandatory basis for

- **E 91.00/ \$ 123.20** per member (**30%** discount on the individual subscription) if **CCLM** copies are sent to the individual members directly from the publisher.  
**E 65.00/ \$88.00** per member (**50%** discount on the individual subscription) if all copies are sent to the society and distributed by the society to the individual members.

All prices include postage and handling and are valid from now to April **30, 2007**.

### **4. Mandatory subscription to CCLM, "print & online" or "online only" subscription**

There is also the possibility of negotiating a special "online-only" subscription rate for your members on a mandatory basis. Offered rates are based on the number of Society members, and, normally, amount to **E 10.00** up to **E 15.00**. Special rates can also be negotiated for a mandatory "print & online" subscription.

Societies that are full members of IFCC and **subscribe to CCLM** on a mandatory basis have the option of receiving **CCLM** as their official **journal**. This information is communicated both on the title page of the journal and on the **CCLM** homepage.
